Special Assessment 217B includes: **Joyce Avenue** from North Avenue to one hundred and fifty (150) feet south of LeMoyné Avenue, **LeMoyné Avenue** from Joyce Avenue to Kramer Avenue, **Edgewood Avenue** from LeMoyné Avenue to Sunset Avenue and **Vista Avenue** from LeMoyné Avenue to Sunset Avenue.

The project is the conversion of the existing rural cross section to an urban cross section. The work includes removing the existing roadway and ditches and constructing a fully improved street. This includes storm sewer, full depth asphalt pavement (9 inches thick), curb and gutter, ornamental street lighting and sidewalks.

Thirty-three (33) potential bidders and suppliers purchased forty-nine (49) sets of bid documents. Public Works Engineering received and opened eleven (11) bids at 11:00 A.M. on February 26, 2009. The results are summarized below:

Due to the number of pay items and the number of bidders, the bid tabulation is not attached. Current PW Engineering staff has worked with the A-Lamp five (5) times over the last eleven (11) years. In 2005 and 2006, A-Lamp worked on two (2) separate storm sewer jobs, with an approximate combined value of \$118,000.

Staff recommendation of award to A-Lamp Concrete Contractors Inc. Schaumburg, Illinois in the amount of \$2,162,972.07 was forwarded to the Board of Local Improvements (BOLI) for their consideration at their meeting of March 12, 2009.
