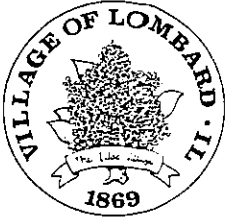

Bids for demolition of 11 E. St. Charles, 19 & 15 E. St. Charles, the Salt Building, and 1 South 421 Finley Road were opened on October 8, 2004. The results are listed below.

United Demolition of Chicago	\$49,475
M & R Demolition of McCook	\$53,800
Focus Environmental of Brookfield	\$79,300
Alpine Demolition of Geneva	\$81,600
National Wrecking of Chicago	\$85,800
K.C.M. Companies of Lombard	\$87,904.10

Two references were checked for United Demolition, and they were positive. I recommend award of a contract for Demolition Services to United Demolition of Chicago in an amount not to exceed \$49,475.00.
