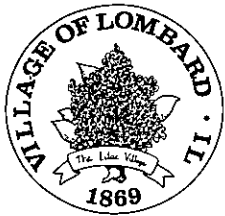

**Subject:** Recommendations from the Transportation and Safety Committee

At the July 12, 2004, Transportation and Safety Committee meeting, the committee recommended the following items:

- Not to restrict traffic entering and exiting the West Suburban Bank facility at 707 N. Main Street.
- The 30 MPH speed limit on LeMoyne Avenue between Main Street and Charlotte Street and on Charlotte Street between LeMoyne Avenue and Goebel Drive remain unposted.
- Installing a wider, more visible crosswalk consisting of 8-inch parallel lines, 12-feet apart with 12-inch perpendicular block style markings on the south leg of St. Charles Road at Main Street.
- Installing 12-inch perpendicular block style markings to the standard crosswalks (6-inch parallel lines, 6-feet apart) on the west, north, and east legs of St. Charles Road at Main Street.
- Installing more visible crosswalks consisting of 8-inch parallel lines, 6-feet apart with 12-inch perpendicular block style markings on the north and east legs of Parkside Avenue at Main Street.
- Installing 12-inch perpendicular block style markings to the standard crosswalk (6-inch parallel lines, 6-feet apart) on the west leg of Parkside Avenue at Main Street.
- Restricting right turns on red from 6:00 AM to 9:00 AM and 4:00 PM to 7:00 PM for westbound Parkside Avenue at Main Street and eastbound St. Charles Road at Main Street.
- Not to install a "Pedestrian Crossing Ahead" sign on the east side of Main Street at the railroad tracks for northbound traffic.
- Installing count down pedestrian signals indicating the time remaining on the pedestrian phase, when the traffic signals on Main Street at St. Charles Road and Parkside Avenue are modified or replaced as part of a future project.
- Reducing the parking on the north side of St. Charles Road, west of Main Street by one car length.

The following sections of the traffic code require an ordinance:

**Add:** Schedule XIII – Right Turns on Red Traffic Signals

- j) westbound traffic on Parkside Avenue shall not turn right on red onto Main Street between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

**Modify:** Schedule XIII – Right Turns on Red Traffic Signals

- f) eastbound traffic on St. Charles Road shall not turn right on red onto Main Street between the hours of 6:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Modify times from 6:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

**Delete:** Schedule X – Section 10-13-10 – Parking Time Limited on Certain Streets

St. Charles Road, north side, from the west curb line of Main Street to 195 feet west of the east curb line of Lincoln Street.

**Add:** Schedule X -- Section 10-13-10 – Parking Time Limited on Certain Streets

St. Charles Road, north side, from 60 feet west of the west curb line of Main Street to 195 feet west of the east curb line of Lincoln Street.

**Add:** Schedule VII – Section 10-13-6 – Parking Prohibited at All Times on Certain Streets

St. Charles Road, north side, from the west curb line of Main Street to 60 feet west.

**ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LOMBARD TRAFFIC CODE**

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule XIII of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled RIGHT TURNS ON RED TRAFFIC SIGNALS be amended to add the following thereto:

- j) westbound traffic on Parkside Avenue shall not turn right on red onto Main Street between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Section 2: That Schedule XIII of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled RIGHT TURNS ON RED TRAFFIC SIGNALS be amended to read as follows

- f) eastbound traffic on St. Charles Road shall not turn right on red onto Main Street between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Section 3: That Schedule X (d) of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PARKING TIME LIMITED ON CERTAIN STREETS during the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. be amended to delete the following therefrom:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>
St. Charles Road North side	west curb line of Main Street	195 feet west of the east curb line of Lincoln Street

Section 4: That Schedule X (d) of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PARKING TIME LIMITED ON CERTAIN STREETS during the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. be amended to add the following thereto:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>
St. Charles Road North side	60 feet west of the west curb line of Main Street	195 feet west of the east curb line of Lincoln Street

Section 5: That Schedule VII of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS be amended to add the following thereto:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>
St. Charles Road North side	west curb line of Main Street	60 feet west

Section 6: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form and the posting of appropriate signs as provided by law.
