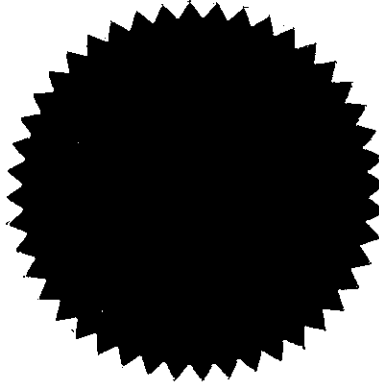

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 9, CHAPTER 91, SECTION 91.21 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION SERVICE

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 9, Chapter 91, Section 91.21 of the Lombard Village Code is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

§ 91.21 FEES

(A) A fee of \$190.00 is hereby imposed upon any resident of the Village of Lombard using emergency medical transportation service provided by the Village of Lombard.

(B) The fee is hereby imposed upon each person not a resident of the Village of Lombard using emergency medical transportation service provided by the Village of Lombard as follows:

- (1) Glenbard Fire Protection District Resident: \$290.00
- (2) Non-resident of Lombard or Glenbard Fire Protection District: \$380.00

(3) A patient(s) who is treated by the Lombard Emergency Medical Service and transferred to a medical helicopter for transport to a hospital shall be billed at the same fee(s) as it was transported by a Lombard ambulance.

(4) A patient(s) who is treated by the Lombard Emergency Medical Service where said treatment involves any type of IV therapy or drug administration and refuses transport shall be billed at the same fee(s) as if transported by a Lombard ambulance.

(C) No fee shall be charged to any person or persons for emergency medical services under the following conditions:

(1) No fee shall be charged to any employee of the Village for emergency medical transportation if that fee relates to injury or illness covered by the Village's worker's compensation.

(2) No fee shall be charged by any person who dies prior to being admitted to the hospital.

(3) A patient who is employed by a business in the Village of Lombard and sustains an injury or illness at his employers business, that employee or business will be billed as follows:

Business in corporate Lombard: \$190.00

Business in Glenbard Fire Protection District: \$290.00

If the employee at a Glenbard Fire Protection District Business is a resident of the Village of Lombard, he will be billed at resident rates.

(4) A patient who is enrolled at a day care facility, preschool, kindergarten, special education facility, elementary school, secondary school, college university or trade school located within the Village of Lombard (hereinafter referred to as the "School" or "Schools") and sustains an injury or illness at said School, that student or School will be billed as follows:

School in corporate Lombard: \$190.00

School in Glenbard Fire Protection District: \$190.00

(5) No fee or a partial fee shall be charged when it is in the best interest of the Village or when the persons are incapable of paying the fee after review and recommendation by the Director of Finance and approval by the Village Manager.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.






