SCRAP METAL, INCLUDING TANKS
Metals and tanks of all types are accepted. Examples of tanks include fire extinguishers, propane tanks (both metal and plastic) and scuba tanks. Lawn mowers and other engines must have plastic components and all liquids removed.

Used Clothing, Furniture & Appliances
Goodwill Industries will collect used clothing in any condition and other items in good condition. Goodwill diverts more than two billion pounds of goods annually from landfills. Clothes unsuitable for reuse are recycled for their fibers.

CELL PHONES
All cellular phones, working or not, and batteries and chargers will be accepted. Phones are donated to Family Shelter Services, a local organization which assists victims of domestic violence. Many will be programmed for 911 calling and others will be recycled for revenue.

CAR & MARINE BATTERIES
All passenger car, truck, marine, RV and light utility batteries for recycling. (No household batteries)

- ELECTRONICS**
- Computers & peripherals including PCs, mainframes, modems, printers, monitors, terminals, drives, plotters, mouse, keyboards, scanners, software discs, CDs & DVDs.
 - Office equipment & products including calculators, telephones, phone systems, answering machines, typewriters, adding machines, fax machines, copy machines, postage machines, pagers and shredders.
 - Entertainment & visual equipment including TVs, VCRs, stereo equipment, cameras, camcorders, video game players and joysticks.
 - Miscellaneous items including humidifiers, microwave ovens, power tools, toasters, vacuums, blenders, blow dryers, curling irons, irons, electric knives and food processors.

BOOKS
Bring your old books. Books that are not rescued (yes, you can pick some up!) will be recycled.

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL BE COLLECTED BY SERVICE ORGANIZATIONS:

BICYCLES & SHOES
The **Rotary Club** will collect bicycles, non-motorized wheelchairs, crutches and canes for **Working Bikes Cooperative**. They will also collect gently used shoes to be donated.

EYEGLASSES, HEARING AIDS
The **Lions Club** will collect eyeglasses, hearing aids and keys.

AMERICAN FLAGS
The **VFW** will accept American Flags for disposal.

FLOWER POTS
The **Glenbard East Ecology Club** will collect clay and ceramic flower pots for re-use. Plastic pots will not be accepted.

The following items are NOT accepted:

- Air conditioners & Dehumidifiers
- Alkaline Batteries *
- Carpeting
- Drywall

- Household chemicals *
- Items with gas or oil
- Lumber & Particle board
- Paint *

- Plaster
- Smoke & CO Detectors
- VHS Tapes
- Windows

*The nearest Household Hazardous Waste site is at Naperville Fire Station #4, 1979 Brookdale Road. Oil paints are accepted but not latex paints, which should be opened to dry completely before discarding the can as normal trash. Hours are Saturday & Sunday 9AM - 2PM.
