Liquor Establishments-Hours of Operation

Please find attached an Ordinance Amending Title 11, Chapter 12 of the Lombard Village Code in regard to liquor licensees and closing hours. This Ordinance has been drafted to address the situation in which a liquor licensee, because of the nature of the business (e.g. bowling alley, restaurant, hotel) desires/needs to stay open for businesses at times during which the sale of alcoholic liquor is prohibited, but with no sale or serving of alcoholic liquor during said times.

ORDINANCE NO. ____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112, SECTION 112.36 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO LIQUOR LICENSEES AND CLOSING HOURS

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.36 of the Lombard Village Code is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"§112.36 CLOSING HOURS.

- (A) Except as provided in subsections (B) and (C) below, it shall be unlawful to sell, offer for sale or to give away, in or upon any licensed premises, any alcoholic liquor between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday; between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on Saturday; and between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. (noon) on Sunday.
- (B) In the case of a Class "M" liquor licensee, it shall be unlawful to remain open to the general public, or sell, offer for sale or to give away, in or upon the licensed premises, any alcoholic liquor between the hours of 12:00 a.m. (midnight) and 6:00 a.m. on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday; between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. on Saturday; and between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. (noon) on Sunday.
- (C) On New Year's Day, the hours limitations set forth in subsections (A) and (B) above shall be extended by one (1) hour as follows:

Regular Time	New Year's Day	
12:00 a.m. (midnight)	1:00 a.m.	
1:00 a.m.	2:00 a.m.	
2:00 a.m.	3:00 a.m.	

(D) It shall be unlawful to keep open for business or to admit the public to any licensed premises in or on which alcoholic liquor is sold at retail during the hours within which the sale of such alcoholic liquor is prohibited, with all patrons being required to vacate the licensed premises where alcoholic

liquor is sold at retail within fifteen (15) minutes after the time when the sale of such alcoholic liquor is prohibited; provided, however, that in the case of all liquor licensees except those holding a Class "D", "F", "I", "L" or "M" liquor license, the establishments of said liquor licensees may be kept open during such hours, but no alcoholic liquor may be sold to, offered for sale to or given to the patrons on the licensed premises during such hours."

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
