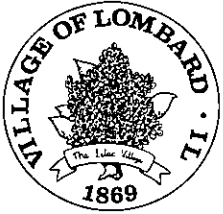

**Subject:** The FY 2007 Sewer Televising and Cleaning Project  
Project Number: SAN-07-02

This contract includes the televising of sewers for planned capital improvement projects (budgeted at \$35,000), and for emergency televising of sewers performed for and funded by underground utility budget. The contract also includes a line item for heavy cleaning that the Village does not have the capability to perform.

Three potential bidders purchased plans for the referenced project. Two bids were received and opened at 1:30 p.m. on September 26, 2006.

The results are listed below:

Engineer's Estimate	\$85,000.00

A&K Underground Inc. has performed satisfactorily on previous Village contracts. The Engineering Division recommends the award of this contract to A&K Underground of Tinley Park, IL.

The cost estimate of \$85,000 includes money for the heavy cleaning of a sewer line. The line starts on Main Street from north of Progress Road and runs south to Crystal Avenue, then west on Crystal to Park Avenue, south on Park to Greenfield Avenue, west on Greenfield to Broadview Avenue, south on Broadview to St. Charles Road and then west on St. Charles to Columbine. The estimate also includes the cleaning of another pipe on Main Street from Willow Street to Washington Boulevard. The capacity on these lines is severely restricted due to sediment building up over the years. Staff recommends that this length of sanitary sewer be cleaned this year.

Staff is recommending awarding a contract in the amount of \$85,000 to cover the anticipated work plus allowing for televising of sewers on an emergency basis. The Department will use work order procedures to issue work to the contractor.

Please present this item to the President and Board of Trustees for their review and approval at their regular meeting on October 5, 2006. If approved, please return two (2) executed copies of the contract to PW Engineering for further processing.

### CONTRACT DOCUMENT NUMBER SAN-07-02

This agreement is made this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2006, between and shall be binding upon the Village of Lombard, an Illinois Municipal Corporation hereinafter referred to as the "Village" and AK Underground hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor" and its successors.

Witnessed, that in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties delineated in the contract documents, the Contractor agrees to perform the services and the Village agrees to pay for the following services as set forth in the contract documents:

#### The FY 2007 Sewer Televising and Cleaning Project

1. This contract shall embrace and include all of the applicable contract documents listed below as if attached hereto or repeated herein:
  - a. Contract Document Number SAN-07-02 for The FY 2007 Sewer Televising and Cleaning Project, consisting of the following:
    - i) Cover Sheet
    - ii) Table of Contents
    - iii) Notice to Bidders on Contract Document Number San-07-02 - Legal Notice
    - iv) General Provisions
    - v) Special Provisions
    - vi) Plans and Specifications
  - b. The Contractor's Bid Proposal Dated: September 26, 2006
  - c. Required Performance and Payment Bonds and Certificate(s) of Insurance
  - d. Executed Bidder's Certification Form.
2. The Village agrees to pay, and the Contractor agrees to accept as full payment as shown on the Contractor's Bid Proposal made a part hereof, subject to additions and deletions as agreed to by the parties hereto.
3. The Contractor shall commence work under this Contract upon written Notice to Proceed from the Village and shall complete work on this project by May 31, 2007. Time is of the essence of this

Contract and Contractor agrees to achieve completion within the contract time by all proper and appropriate means including working overtime without additional compensation.

4. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 5 of the Mechanics' Lien Act of Illinois, prior to making any payment on this contract the Village demands that the Contractor furnish a written statement of the names of all parties furnishing labor and/or materials under this Contract and the amounts due or to become due on each. This statement must be made under oath or be verified by affidavit. The Village shall not issue final payment nor shall any retained percentage become due until releases and waivers of lien have been supplied as the Village designates.
5. This Contract represents the entire Agreement between the parties and may not be modified without the written approval of both parties.
