Subject: Vehicle Replacements, CSO #206 vehicle crash

Earlier this year a Community Service Officer was involved in a vehicle crash that resulted in the 2016 Ford Transit Connect being totaled by the Village's insurance provider. This vehicle was due for replacement in 2022.

The Police Department has requested that the vehicle is replaced with a 2022 Ford F-150 4x4 truck. The features on a F-150 4x4 vehicle will help the Police Department respond more effectively to emergency calls in inclement weather situations.

The estimated replacement cost for CSO, PP206 (transit connect) is \$26,000. The village currently has approximately \$19,200 in reserves and has received a check from the insurance company for \$16,000. Total funds available for the replacement of PP206 is \$35,200.
