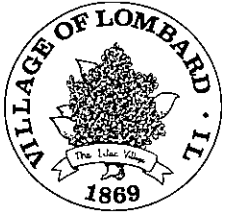

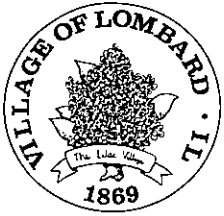

SUBJECT: Asphalt Paver, Roller and Trailer Purchase
Waiver of Bid Requested

During the Fleet Review budget meeting the expansion of the in house-paving program of the Street reconstruction division of Public Works was discussed. In order to pave our wider streets in two passes we need to upgrade our current paving equipment. We need a paver that has a 15-foot wide paving width. Only one manufacturer offers a paver of this size priced under \$100,000. This is the same brand of paver we are currently using. The larger paving machine will require additional support equipment. We will need a trailer for the new paver and an additional asphalt roller. Street division Supervisor Steve Kremske, Crew Leader Chris Bohnert and myself reviewed these models at the dealer. We all agree that the equipment we had demonstrated will do the job.

The following is a breakdown of the pricing for all the equipment needed:

Econoline Trailer model MP1226	\$10,100

Trade-in of our 1998 paver	-19,500

Funding for these purchases will come from the following sources:

Capital Projects Fund (\$50,000 budgeted)	\$50,000

In order to have this equipment delivered for the start of the paving season I am requesting the Board of Trustees waive bid, award a contract to Casey Equipment Co. of Arlington Heights, the LeeBoy authorized dealer in the amount of \$111,653 (paver, roller and trailer) and authorize the trade-in of Village unit # ST-945 (1998 LeeBoy 1000 Paver)

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND/OR DISPOSAL
OF MUNICIPAL OWNED PERSONAL PROPERTY**
