AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11,
CHAPTER 112 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "T" liquor license, contained therein to read as follows:

Class "T" - 0

This decrease in Class "T" liquor licenses reflects the sale of the assets of Residence Inn by Marriott Inc. d/b/a Residence Inn and the termination of the Class "T" liquor license issued to Residence Inn by Marriott Inc. in relation thereto.

Section 2: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "T" liquor license, contained therein to read as follows:

Class "T" - 1

This increase in Class "T" liquor license reflects the issuance of a Class "T" liquor license to Residence Inn by Marriott LLC who will be operating the business commonly known as Residence Inn located at 2001 S. Highland Avenue, Lombard.

Section 3: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.12(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended to read as follows:

"Class "T" - Beer and wine only served at no charge for consumption by patrons of the hotel on the premises of a hotel without a restaurant (manager's reception); packaged sales of beer and wine are allowed to be sold provided all beer and wine on display for sale shall be kept in a locked display case with only the cashier being able to unlock said display case. If a hotel currently has a Class "O" liquor license, said hotel need not also obtain a Class "T" liquor license."

Section 4: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.




