BACKGROUND/POLICY IMPLICATIONS: The Zoning Board of Appeals transmits for your consideration its recommendation relative to the above-mentioned petition. This petition requests that the Village take the following actions for the subject property located within the R2 Single-Family Residence District:		
1. A variation from Section $155.205(A)(1)(c)(2)$ of the Lombard Zoning Ordinance to increase the maximum allowable fence height in a corner side yard from four feet (4') to six feet (6').		
2. A variation from Section 155.205(A)(1)(e) of the Lombard Zoning Ordinance to allow a solid wood fence six feet (6') in height in the clear line of sight area.		
The Zoning Board of Appeals voted on each variation separately and their recommendation is noted below:		
Variation #2 A variation from Section 155.205(A)(1)(e) of the Lombard Zoning Ordinance to allow a solid wood fence six feet (6') in height in the clear line of sight area. The ZBA recommended denial by a vote of 6-0.		
Variation #1 A variation from Section 155.205(A)(1)(c)(2) of the Lombard Zoning Ordinance to increase the maximum allowable fence height in a corner side yard from four feet (4') to six feet (6'). As their were neither four votes to approve or deny the variation, it is being forwarded to the Board of Trustees with no recommendation.
