Ridge Avenue Drainage Improvements Preliminary Design Engineering (Phase 1)

Attached please find a resolution, contract and fee schedule for Preliminary Design Engineering services (Phase 1) for the 900 block of North Ridge Avenue. The intent of the work is to determine the most prudent long term solution to "fix" the localized roadway and underground utility settlement which are the source of the localized flooding occurring on Ridge Avenue.

A Request for Proposal (RFP) was sent to the Hydraulic and Hydrology Engineering Short-List. Four of the five firms responded. Baxter & Woodman was determined to be the most qualified firm for the project. Baxter & Woodman has previously performed preliminary engineering for the Route 53 Pump Station Replacement project in 2010 thru 2012 and the design engineering for the Lift Station Improvement project in 2011 thru 2012.

The scope and fee were negotiated agreed to by both parties. The project consists of obtaining and evaluating background information, performing drainage analysis, analyzing the geotechnical conditions, and formulating/designing preliminary engineering solutions to remedy the existing condition of Ridge Avenue. A Preliminary Design Report (PDR) will be submitted for Village staff review and evaluation. The findings will be presented and discussed with the affected property owners on Ridge Avenue. This work will be performed for a not-to-exceed design engineering fee of \$51,465.00. Engineering costs will be paid for using the Water and Sewer Capital Reserve Fund.

Please present this agreement and resolution to the President and Board of Trustees for their review at their regular meeting of December 4, 2014. If approved, please return one original signed copy to Public Works-Engineering for further processing.
