WHEREAS, there are approximately 40 different paratransit programs currently providing service within DuPage County, where “paratransit” is defined as demand-responsive, door-to-door (or curb-to-curb) transportation service, and where paratransit rider eligibility, limited to persons with disabilities and seniors for some programs, is determined by the funding sources; and

WHEREAS, there have been efforts to coordinate some of these programs and these coordination efforts have resulted in increased service and cost efficiency, and elimination of duplication; and

WHEREAS, there is still a significant unmet travel need among seniors and persons with disabilities, an unmet need that will also increase substantially over the years; and

WHEREAS, efforts to increase coordination among these paratransit programs has been determined to be a mechanism to accommodate some of the unmet need.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS that we intend to continue to continue membership in the Inter-Agency Paratransit Coordinating Council (IAPCC).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Village President is hereby authorized to execute the Memorandum of Understanding of the Inter-Agency Paratransit Coordinating Council attached hereto as exhibit “A” noting that this Memorandum of Understanding documents the intention to continue the pursuit of the establishment of the Inter-Agency Paratransit Coordinating Council but does not signify as commitment for funding.

And whereas the IAPCC successfully launched Ride DuPage in 2004,


And whereas there continues to be a need for expanded transportation options for persons with limited mobility, including seniors, persons with disabilities, and low-income workers,


Therefore, **Village of Lombard** establishes its membership in the IAPCC and aligns itself with the principles of the IAPCC which are:


- to work collaboratively across agency boundaries, municipal borders, and funding sources to provide transportation options,

- to serve as a local, regional, and national resource to organizations with similar missions.


As a member, **Village of Lombard** will:
