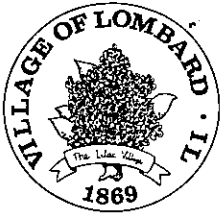

ORDINANCE _____
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "A/B III" liquor license, contained therein, to read as follows, effective May 1, 2007:

Class "A/B III" - 12

This increase in Class "A/B III" liquor licenses reflects the issuance of a Class "A/B III" liquor license to the Bravo Development Inc., located at 330 Yorktown Center, Lombard who will be operating the business commonly known as Brio Tuscan Grille.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
