"No Parking" Various Streets in Cambria Neighborhood

Village Staff is requesting a change to the Village Traffic Code to post "No Parking" signs on East Wilson Avenue (east of Westmore-Meyers Road); East Addison Avenue; South Addison Avenue (south of Jackson Street and north of East Addison Avenue); Cambria Lane North; and, Cambria Lane South. This change is requested as the result of coordination with the Lombard Police Department, the Cambria Homeowners Association, the Islamic Foundation, and Trustee Soderstrom. The signs will read:

"No Parking, Friday from Noon to 3 PM"

This action was initiated by Temporary Police Order (see attached) to eliminate the parking and access problems that were occurring in the Cambria neighborhood during the above noted hours as the mosque has insufficient parking and attendees were parking in the now restricted areas.

This item will be on the September 12, 2006 Transportation and Safety Committee agenda. The meeting is held at the Village Hall in the Community Room at 7:00 PM. This is a public meeting and public participation is encouraged.
