No Parking Zones on Lincoln Avenue north of St. Charles Road

Staff has investigated a sight distance issue for residents exiting the multi-family residential parking lots on the east and west sides of Lincoln Avenue. Our investigation revealed vehicles parked on Lincoln Avenue near the entrances of the residential parking lots could inhibit driver sight distance. This information is depicted on the attached map. Therefore, staff recommends posting "No Parking" on the east and west sides of Lincoln Avenue, just north of St. Charles Road, as follows:
