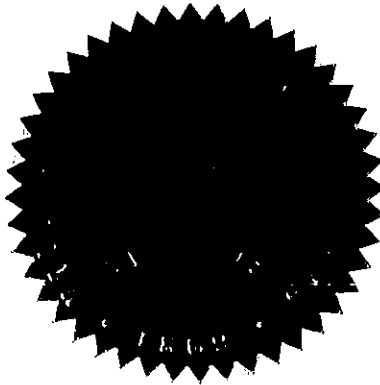



ORDINANCE NO. 4979

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 7, CHAPTER 72,
SECTION 72.04 (B) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE
IN REGARD TO IMMOBILIZATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES**

Be It Ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois as follows:

Section 1: That Title 7, Chapter 72, Section 72.04 (B)(3) is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"(3) Deposit collateral in the amount of the number of outstanding complaints listed in the notice of eligibility for immobilization times fifteen dollars (\$15.00), but not to exceed five hundred dollars \$500.00), and execute an agreement to present copies of appearances filed with the clerk of the Circuit Court of DuPage County on all outstanding complaints specified in the notice of eligibility for immobilization within twenty-one (21) days from the date of the agreement. Such collateral shall be returned upon receipt of copies of the appearances, but shall be forfeited if the owner does not present such copies and the forfeited collateral may not be used to satisfy any unpaid fees or penalties. Upon forfeiture of collateral, the motor vehicle involved shall again be subject to immediate immobilization and no further deposit of collateral as described in this subsection shall again be allowed as a method of release; or"

Section 2: That Title 7, Chapter 72, Section 72.04 (B) hereby is amended by adding subsection (4) to read in its entirety:

"(4) Pay fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per outstanding complaint and sign an installment agreement to pay the remainder of the amount owed over a period of time. Each payment made under the installment agreement will be applied to the total amount due and no one (1) or more outstanding complaint(s) shall be considered paid until the entire amount due for all outstanding complaints is paid. If payments are not made as required in the installment agreement, the agreement shall become void, the motor vehicle shall be subject to re-immobilization and the original amount due (less any amount paid) plus additional charges for re-immobilization shall become due. No further option under this subsection (B) (4) shall be available; and"

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.



**VILLAGE OF LOMBARD
VEHICLE IMMOBILIZATION PROGRAM
INSTALLMENT AGREEMENT**

As a result of the following attached parking tickets issued by the Lombard Police Department, the undersigned, _____, (hereinafter referred to as the "VIOLATOR") does hereby agree to effect a settlement of the fines due the Village of Lombard (hereinafter referred to as the "VILLAGE"), in lieu of having his/her vehicle immobilized pursuant to Title 7, Chapter 72 of the Lombard Village Code, on the following terms:

1. VIOLATOR agrees to pay the sum of _____ DOLLARS (\$ _____) to the Village at the rate of _____ DOLLARS (\$ _____) per month, with the first payment due on _____, 20____, and with the final payment of _____ DOLLARS (\$ _____) due on _____, 20____.

2. Should VIOLATOR comply with the provisions of Section 1 above, the VILLAGE shall refrain from immobilizing the VIOLATOR'S vehicle for the attached parking tickets, and will issue a Release to the VIOLATOR upon receipt of the last payment.

3. Each payment made under this Agreement shall be applied to the total amount due and no one (1) or more outstanding parking ticket(s) shall be considered paid until the entire amount is paid. If payments are not made as required by this Agreement, the Agreement shall be void, the motor vehicle shall be subject to immobilization under Title 7, Chapter 72 of the Lombard Village Code and the original amount due (less any amount paid) plus additional charges for re-immobilization shall become due. In addition, the option of release of immobilization by installment agreement shall no longer be available.
