Subject: FY2020 Vehicle Replacement, Vactor Sewer Truck

In the FY2020 budget is the replacement of a Public Works sewer flusher truck (unit # SM455, a 2009 Vactor Jetter). Staff would like to replace this truck with a combination jet and vac sewer truck. The new truck will be able to vacuum sewers as well as flush them to improve operational efficiency. Combination sewer trucks also have the ability to hydro-excavate. This type of digging is useful when repairing underground utilities because it more precise than digging with a backhoe and therefore less restoration work has to be done to surrounding landscape. Since the lead time for this truck is approximately 9 months, staff is seeking approval to order the new truck now. By ordering the truck now the Village also can avoid a July 1st price increase on this truck.

The Vactor combination sewer truck is available for joint purchase through the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative (SPC contract # 161). The current contract winner for the SPC is Standard Equipment of Chicago (IL). The cost of the truck is \$407,685. Standard Equipment has offered \$30,000 in trade -in allowance for our old flushing truck (unit # SM455). Staff considers this to be a fair amount and therefore would not be able to get a better return marketing and selling such a specialized piece of equipment elsewhere. The net cost of this purchase with trade is \$377,685. The budgeted amount in reserve for this vehicle is \$375,000. The \$2,685 deficit will be made up by savings projected on other FY2020 vehicle sale/purchases.

I recommend the Board of Trustees waive bid and award a contract to Standard Equipment of Chicago (IL) in the amount of \$377,685 for a new Vactor combination sewer truck. I also recommend declaring Village unit number SM455 as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorizing its trade-in to Standard Equipment. Waiver of first reading is requested on this ordinance. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the July 18, 2019 meeting.

This is to inform you that the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative (SPC) Governing Board has approved the second of three (3) possible one- year contract extensions to Standard Equipment, Chicago, on the 10 Yard Fan Catch Basin/Sewer Cleaner (contract #161) and 12 Yard Fan Catch Basin/Sewer Cleaner (contract #162) from December 9, 2018 through December 8, 2019, with no price increase at this time. The SPC reserves the right to award the final one-year terms upon mutual agreement of both the vendor and the SPC on a negotiated basis.

Standard Equipment will handle billing.
