**SUBJECT: Request for Class A Coin-Operated License  
Noon Whistle – 800 E. Roosevelt Road**

Noon Whistle recently expanded their business into the adjacent existing tenant space for the purposes of accommodating special events such as team outings, small weddings and business meetings. They added a small kitchen, banquet space, private meeting room, and outdoor seating as well as expanded the tasting area. To coincide with the expansion and in an effort to provide their customers with an enhanced experience, Mike Condon, owner of Noon Whistle, has requested that they be allowed to have six (6) coin-operated amusement devices on site. Six (6) coin-operated amusement devices require a Class A coin-operated amusement device license.

Coin-operated devices are one of many types of business licenses. Village Code Title XI, Chapter 110, Section 110.21(C) states there shall be issued no more than the stated number of annual coin-operated licenses. These licenses are categorized into two Classes:

Class A—number of business establishments that have four to eight coin-operated devices on site.  
Class B—number of business establishments that have over eight coin-operated devices on site.

Currently there are two (2) licenses issued in the Class A category (Brauerhouse and Lombard Roller Rink). Attached is an ordinance increasing the allowable licenses under the Class A coin-operated license category from two (2) to three (3) to account for the aforementioned request.

The petitioner is requesting a waiver of first reading so that the coin-operated devices can be active.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XI, CHAPTER 110,  
SECTION 110.21(C) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE  
IN REGARD TO THE NUMBER OF  
CLASS A COIN-OPERATED LICENSES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:**

**SECTION 1:** That Title XI, Chapter 110, Section 110.21(C) of the Lombard Village Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

(C) In addition to the license required by Subsection (B) for each individual coin-operated amusement device, there shall be issued no more than the stated number of annual licenses in the following classifications for persons, firms, corporations or associations displaying for public patronage or keeping for operation any coin-operated amusement device:

Class A

Four (4) to eight (8) coin-operated amusement devices

No more than three (3) licenses.

**SECTION 2:** That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
