Subject: Operation Lifesaver Presentation to the Board of Trustees on June 1, 2006

At the June 1, 2006 Board of Trustees Meeting the Illinois Chapter of Operation Lifesaver will brief the Board and Residents on actions that can be taken to improve safety at rail crossings and around tracks.

Operation Lifesaver is a national, non-profit organization whose mission is to reduce and end tragic collisions, fatalities and injuries at highway-rail grade crossings and on railroad rights of way. The organization focuses its efforts on the three E's; Education, Enforcement and Engineering. The Organization educates drivers and pedestrians to enable them to make safe decisions at rail crossings and around tracks. They promote enforcement of traffic laws relating to crossings and trespassing laws. They also encourage engineering research and innovation to improve the safety of railroad crossings.
