SUBJECT: An Ordinance Amending Title VII, Chapter 75, Section 75.06 of the Lombard Village Code In Regard to the Seizure and Impoundment of Motor Vehicles.

BACKGROUND/POLICY IMPLICATIONS: Public Act 99-0848 has been passed by the Illinois Legislature and requires non-home rule municipalities to add a provision as it relates to the seizure and impoundment of motor vehicles used in crimes. Specifically, the Public Act requires municipalities who are found to have exceeded their authority in seizing a vehicle to reimburse owners and lessees for the cost of storage fees and reasonable attorney's fees. The required ordinance to comply with the Public Act has been prepared by the Village Attorney. A waiver of first reading is being requested so that the municipal code is in compliance with the new state law.
