Mosquito Abatement Contract

At the February 22, 2005 meeting, the Environmental Concerns Committee unanimously recommended waiver of bids and approval of the attached Mosquito Abatement Contract with Clarke Mosquito.

This contract shows the base program price, but any sprayings are an additional cost based on the unit prices in the contract. Budgeted amount is \$115,000.

DuPage County will again provide four Gravid Traps free of charge in the Lombard area (two in Lombard, two just outside Village boundaries). Gravid Traps attract the Culex mosquito, the main vector of West Nile Virus. The County's assistance saves the Village at least \$24,000 a year on the Clarke contract. Village staff will carefully monitor conditions and focus control efforts on areas within the community where mosquito activity is the greatest.

Pursuant to the Committee's recommendation, I also recommend waiver of bids and award of a contract to Clarke Environmental Mosquito Management, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$115,000. The contract allows the Village to spray when required or add catch basins when additional are found. Last year, the Village sprayed four times to assist in controlling the mosquitoes that carry West Nile Virus.

Treatments may be on a section or city basis at a cost of \$64.70 per mile (minimum of 5 miles).
