SUBJECT: Request for Class A Coin-Operated License - Lombard Roller Rink, 201 W. 22nd Street and Amending the Number of Class A Licenses

Coin-operated devices are one of many types of business licenses that are renewed annually. Village Code Title 11, Chapter 110, Section 110.21(C) states there shall be issued no more than the stated number of annual coin-operated licenses. These licenses are categorized into two Classes:

Class A—number of business establishments that have four to eight coin-operated devices on site.

Class B—number of business establishments that have over eight coin-operated devices on site.

Currently there are six (6) licenses issued in the Class A category and two (2) licenses issued in the Class B category.

Staff has received a request from Lombard Roller Rink located at 201 W. 22nd Street to allow them to have a Class A coin-operated license. Together with Lombard Roller Rink's request, staff is amending the number of Class A licenses, which is determined through our annual licensing process, as Yorktown AMC, Buffalo Wild Wings, Miller's Ale House, and Roundhead's Pizza Pub have eliminated or decreased their number of on-site coin operated devices and no longer qualify to have a Class A license. Consequently, the number of licenses in the Class A category has been amended from six (6) to three (3) to reflect these changes. The number of Class B licenses remains unchanged at two (2).

Attached is an ordinance decreasing the allowable licenses under the Class A coin-operated license category from six (6) to three (3) to account for the aforementioned matters.

Due to the Board of Trustees summer schedule, staff is requesting a waiver of first reading.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 110,
SECTION 110.21(C) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE
IN REGARD TO THE NUMBER OF
CLASS A COIN-OPERATED LICENSES**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 110, Section 110.21(C) of the Lombard Village Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

(C) In addition to the license required by subsection (B) for each individual coin-operated amusement device, there shall be issued no more than the stated number of annual licenses in the following classifications for persons, firms, corporations or associations displaying for public patronage or keeping for operation any coin-operated amusement device:

Class A

Four to eight coin-operated amusement devices.

No more than ~~six~~ three licenses.

Class B

More than eight coin-operated amusement devices.

No more than two licenses.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
