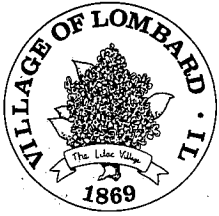


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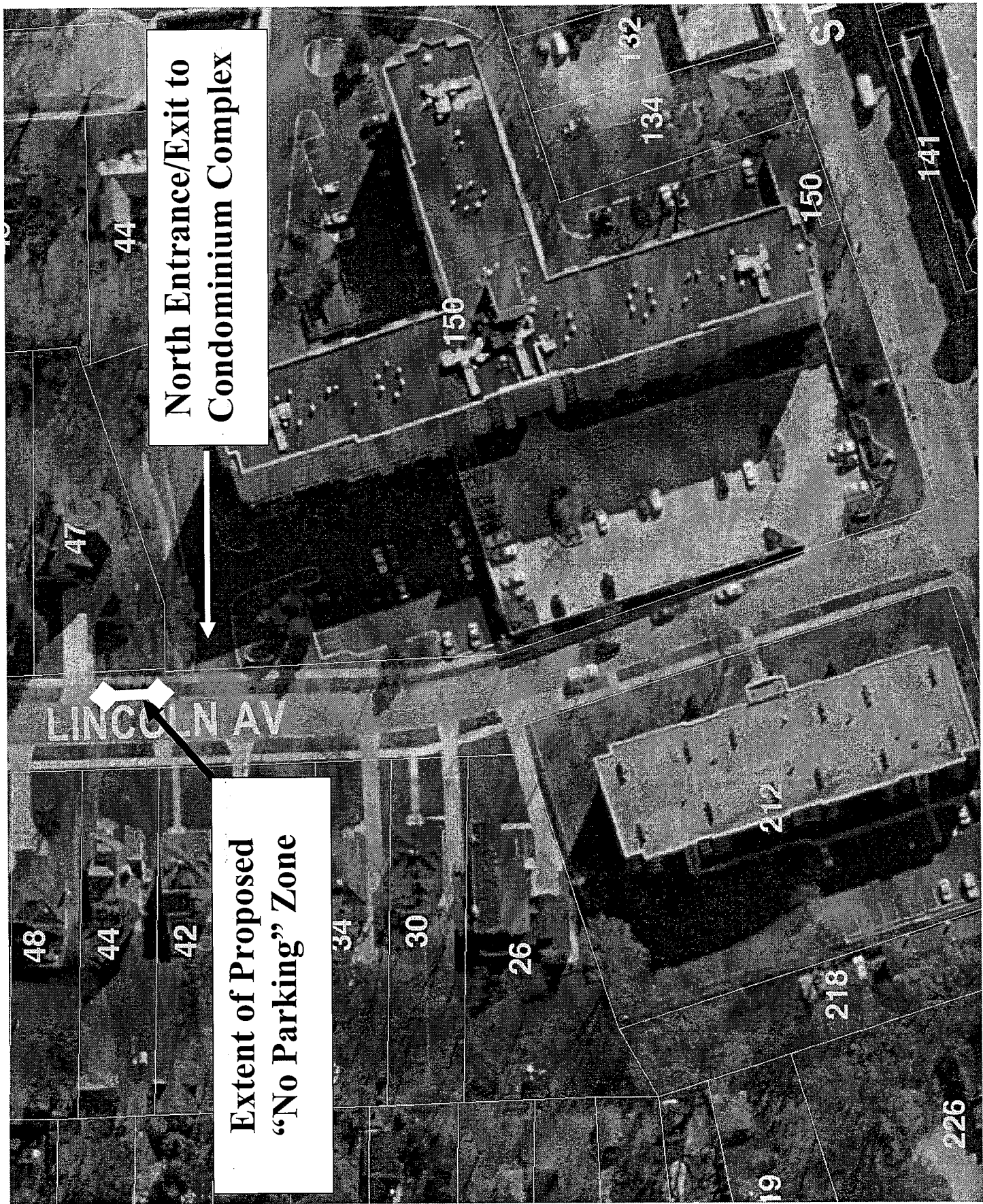

Subject: "No Parking" Lincoln Park Condominiums – Lincoln Avenue

A sight-distance issue was brought forward by David Hulseberg, Assistant Village Manager, for the intersection of Lincoln Avenue and the northern entrance/exit of Lincoln Park Condominiums. Staff requests a change to the Village Traffic Code to post "No Parking" on the east side of Lincoln Avenue, from a point 502 feet north from the curb of the northeast corner of Lincoln Avenue and St. Charles Road, to a point 547 feet from the same curb. This posting effectively removes an available on street parking spot that, when occupied, provides a significant obstruction for vehicles exiting the condominium complex. This item will be on the November 6, 2006 Transportation and Safety Committee agenda. The meeting is held at the Village Hall in the Community Room at 7:00 PM. This is a public meeting and public participation is encouraged.
