## ORDINANCE NO. 6197

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 6131, ADOPTED DECEMBER 7, 2007, IN REGARD TO THE PAVING AND IMPROVING OF PORTIONS OF LALONDE AVENUE, MARCUS DRIVE AND JOYCE AVENUE (SPECIAL ASSESSMENT NO. 217A)

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That in light of the fact that the Village of Lombard was able to sell bonds to finance this improvement at an interest rate of less than nine percent (9%), Section 6 of Ordinance No. 6131, adopted December 7, 2007, is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"SECTION 6: The aggregate amount herein ordered to be assessed and each individual assessment shall be divided into fifteen (15) installments which shall bear interest at the rate of 5.128% until paid, all in the manner and in accordance with the provisions of 65 ILCS 5/9-2-1 through 5/9-2-144, as supplemented by the provisions of 50 ILCS 460/1 through 460/65, which the Village hereby elects to be applicable to this Special Assessment."

**SECTION 2:** That all other provisions of Ordinance No. 6131, adopted December 7, 2007, shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 3:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
