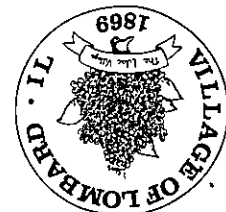

**Subject:** Recommendation from the Transportation and Safety Committee

The Transportation and Safety Committee, at their August 7<sup>th</sup> meeting, voted unanimously to approve the following item:

- 060370 – Changing the intersection of Highland Ave. and Washington Blvd. from a two-way stop to a four-way stop by adding stop signs on eastbound and westbound Washington Blvd.

The action was reviewed at the request of local residents. The primary concern was the number of accidents that have occurred at this intersection, as the result of limited sight distance for vehicles that are stopped on Highland Ave. An analysis of the intersection resulted in vehicle and accident volumes that would not typically warrant a stop sign; however, due to the limited sight distance caused by large, full trees and utility poles, staff recommended stopping oncoming traffic on Washington Blvd. This is an optional criteria for deciding to install a multi-way stop that is provided in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices as: "Locations where a road user, after stopping, cannot see conflicting traffic and is not able to reasonably safely negotiate the intersection unless conflicting cross traffic is also required to stop." Please present this item to the Board of Trustees at their regularly scheduled meeting on August 17, 2006 in accordance with the Committee's recommendation.

**ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LOMBARD TRAFFIC CODE**

ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule III of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled STOP INTERSECTIONS be amended to add the following thereto:

Washington Blvd. and Highland Ave.

Section 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form and the posting of appropriate signs as provided by law.
