BACKGROUND/POLICY IMPLICATIONS:

Attached for your consideration is an ordinance amending Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.12, amending Class "SS" liquor classification to add the manufacturing, tastings, sale of, and consumption of cider and mead products on an off the license premises and allowing the licensee to prepare food on the licensed premises. Currently, there is one establishment that holds the Class "SS" liquor license and one prospective licensee, Dyslexia, a Craft Alcohol Production Facility, that the Board of Trustees recently approved a Conditional Use Permit for 109 S. Main St.

Staff is requesting a waiver of first reading.

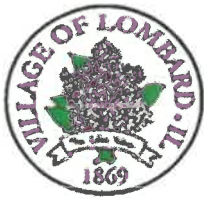

## MEMORANDUM

**SUBJECT:** Class “SS” Liquor License Category

Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.12 of the Village Code currently defines the Class “SS” liquor license category as:

The manufacturing of beer products on the licensed premises, for consumption on the licensed premises, along with the sale of said beer products manufactured on the licensed premises, as well as beer products manufactured by the licensee off of the licensed premises, for consumption off of the licensed premises. In addition to beer products manufactured on the licensed premises, beer and cider not manufactured on the licensed premises may be sold for consumption on the licensed premises. Tastings of all beer and cider sold for consumption on the licensed premises are allowed. Patrons may bring food to the licensed premises, for consumption on the licensed premises, but no food shall be prepared on the licensed premises. Pre-packaged snacks, such as pretzels and potato chips in the manufacturer’s original packaging, may be sold or provided on the licensed premises. The liquor licensee shall be required to comply with all applicable federal and state regulations relating to the manufacturing of beer products. Video gaming, as provided for under the Illinois Video Gaming Act, shall not be allowed on the licensed premises.

Village staff is requesting to amend this code to include “Cider” and “Mead Products” an alcoholic beverage, fermented from honey and water, within the description of the current Class “SS” liquor license category.

Additionally, the amended description will now allow the licensee to prepare food on the licensed premises.

Attached is an ordinance amending Village Code Title XI, Chapter 112, Section 112.12, Class "SS" liquor license category, adding the manufacturing, tastings, sale of, and consumption of cider and mead products on and off of the licensed premises, and allowing the licensee to prepare food on the licensed premises to serve the customers.

Currently there is one establishment that holds a Class "SS". A prospective licensee, Dyslexia, a Craft Alcohol Production Facility, recently approved for a Conditional Use Permit, 109 S. Main Street, at the September 1, 2022 Board of Trustees Meeting, is requesting the Class "SS" liquor license.

Staff is requesting a waiver of first reading.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE XI, CHAPTER 112,  
SECTION 112.12 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE  
IN REGARD TO LIQUOR LICENSE CLASS "SS" REGULATIONS**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1:** That the definition of, and requirements and regulations for the Class "SS" liquor license classification, contained in Title XI, Chapter 112, Article II, Section 112.12(A) of the Lombard Village Code, are hereby amended to read in their entirety as follows:

"Class "SS"—The manufacturing of beer, cider, and mead products on the licensed premises, for consumption on the licensed premises, along with the sale of said beer, cider, and mead products manufactured on the licensed premises, as well as beer, cider, and mead products manufactured by the licensee off of the licensed premises, for consumption off of the licensed premises. In addition to beer, cider, and mead products manufactured on the licensed premises, beer and cider not manufactured on the licensed premises may be sold for consumption on the licensed premises. Tastings of all beer, mead and cider sold for consumption on the licensed premises are allowed. Patrons may bring food to the licensed premises, for consumption on the licensed premises. Food may also be prepared by the licensee on the licensed premises for service to patrons, subject to the licensee obtaining all necessary permits and complying with all requirements under applicable law related to food preparation and service on the licensed premises. Pre-packaged snacks, such as pretzels and potato chips in the manufacturer's original packaging, may also be sold or provided on the licensed premises. The licensee shall be required to comply with all applicable federal and state regulations relating to the manufacturing of beer and mead products. Video gaming, as provided for under the Illinois Video Gaming Act, shall not be allowed on the licensed premises."

**SECTION 2:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
