090585; Ordinance to Limit Parking in Municipal Parking Lots during Significant Snow Events

On October 5, 2009, the Transportation and Safety Committee discussed the need to create a mechanism that would insure adequate snow removal operations in commuter lots. Currently, complete snow removal following a significant snow event (1" or greater) is not always possible because of vehicles sporadically parked for extended periods of time. These occurrences result in the stockpiling of snow in parking stalls that could otherwise generate revenue and creates an undue financial burden on the Public Works Department to re-deploy personnel and equipment to multiple sites for later snow removal after vehicles are moved.

In recognizing the inability of commuters to remove vehicles during the typical working hours, limiting the parking restriction from 2 am to 5 am after a major snow event (1" or greater) would provide the Public Works Department a 3 hour window to clear the subject lots. This parking restriction extends the current on-street parking limitations, as noted in Section 10-13-12 of the Village Traffic Code, Ordinance 1186, to public municipal parking lots. Furthermore, the extension of this ordinance to Municipal Parking Lots has no affect on current Metra or private company agreements for commuter or condominium resident parking.

Also, two (2) municipal parking lots (Orchard Terrace and the Premier Commuter Lots) have been recently created and should be identified in the Traffic Code.

The Committee voted to recommend extending the existing on-street snow removal parking restrictions to the Municipal Parking Lots and to update the Traffic Code with new commuter lot information. These actions require an ordinance to the Traffic Code as follows.

<p>SCHEDULE XXIII – MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS</p> <p>(a) In accordance with Section 10-13-12, Parking Limited during Snow Removal, and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle upon any of the following lots between the hours of 2:00 am and 5:00 am.</p>

ORDINANCE NO. _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
ARTICLE XIII AND SCHEDULE XXIII OF THE
LOMBARD TRAFFIC CODE (ORDINANCE NO. 1186)
IN RELATION TO MUNICIPAL PARKING LOTS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Article XIII, Section 10-13-12 of the Lombard Traffic Code is hereby amended by labeling the current provisions thereof as subsection (A), and adding a new subsection (B) which shall read in its entirety as follows:

“(B) For parking restrictions relative to municipal parking lots after a snowfall of one (1) inch or more, see Section 10-13-24(B) of this Traffic Code.”

SECTION 2: That Article XIII, Section 10-13-24 of the Lombard Traffic Code is hereby amended by labeling the current provisions thereof as subsection (A), and adding a new subsection (B) which shall read in its entirety as follows:

“(B) It shall be unlawful to park any motor vehicle within any municipal parking lot as described in Schedule XXIII at any time between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m., after snow begins to fall, if the snow within the municipal parking lot is one (1) inch or more in depth, as determined by the Director of Public Works or his representative.

The Director of Public Works, or his representative, shall immediately notify the media and Police Department when he determines that snow within any municipal parking lot is one (1) inch or more in depth.”

SECTION 3: That Schedule XXIII of the Lombard Traffic Code is hereby amended by adding new subsections 12 and 13 thereto, which shall read in their entirety as follows:

“12. Orchard Terrace Commuter Lot, which is located at the Southwest corner of Orchard Terrace and Park Avenue on Permanent Tax Index Number 06-07-204-022.

13. Premier Parking Commuter Lot, which is located at the Southwest corner of Parkside Avenue and Main Street on Permanent Tax Index Number 06-07-213-015.”

SECTION 4: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form and the posting of the appropriate signs as provided by law.
