**Subject:** Recommendation from the Transportation and Safety Committee

---

At the April 12, 2004, Transportation and Safety Committee meeting, the committee reviewed and approved the following items:

- Install “Yield Here to Pedestrians” signs and yield pavement markings on the east and west side of Westmore/Meyers Road at the Illinois Prairie Path crossing.
- Install a center concrete median on Main Street at the Illinois Prairie Path crossing and post “Yield Here to Pedestrians” in-street signs.

Article IX, Section 10-9-1(c), of the Village Traffic Code requires drivers to yield to pedestrians in a marked crosswalk between intersections. The proposed signage reminds motorists of this obligation.

The total estimated cost of the concrete median on Main Street, “Yield Here to Pedestrians” signs and pavement markings is \$8,000.00.
