SUBJECT: **Text Amendment to Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A)**
Number of Authorized Liquor Licenses

Harry Caray's currently holds an A/B-IV liquor license. Holy Mackerel currently holds an A/B-II liquor license. While both businesses maintain separate liquor licenses, HC Management Lombard LLC serves as Licensee on both liquor licenses and they operate as one entity.

Recently staff received a request from HC Management Lombard LLC requesting that Holy Mackerel's liquor license be absorbed into Harry Caray's liquor license. This request is in response to the State of Illinois Liquor Commission having issues with the business operations of HC Management Lombard LLC as it pertains to having two separate liquor licenses while operating as one entity.

In an effort to remedy the situation, staff is presenting the attached ordinance. The number of licenses in the Class A/B-II category would be reduced by one (1) to reflect the removal of the Holy Mackerel license. This would allow HC Management Lombard LLC to have one liquor license for both businesses under the Class A/B-IV license. One liquor license would then be re-issued to HC Management Lombard LLC d/b/a Harry Caray's Lombard/Holy Mackerel.

HC Management LLC is requesting a waiver of first reading in order to satisfy the timeline imposed by the State Liquor Commission.

ORDINANCE _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS** as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended BY REVISING THE ENTRY RELATIVE TO THE Class A/B-II liquor licenses contained therein, to read as follows:

“Class A/B-II – 10”

Section 2: That the change in the number of Class A/B-II liquor licenses set forth in Section 1 above, is a result of H.C. Management Lombard LLC’s request to have Holy Mackerel’s liquor license absorbed into Harry Caray’s existing liquor license classification of A/B-IV.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
