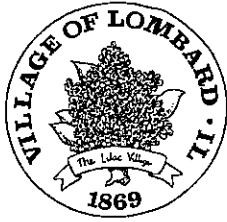

## MEMORANDUM

**Subject:** Fire Hydrants Bid

On Tuesday, August 10, 2004, bids were opened for Fire Hydrants. Six bids were sent out and four companies responded:

National Waterworks, Inc.  
Carol Stream, IL 60188

Ziebell Water Service Products  
Elk Grove, IL 60007

Water Products Company  
Aurora, IL 60507

Mid American Water, Inc.  
Aurora, IL 60505

Bids were broken down into two categories and they were as follows: Category I-Fire Hydrant Extensions and Category II-Fire Hydrants. The total cost of each category was based upon projected need during the upcoming year. The total cost of the bid was based upon the total of all categories. The four companies submitted prices on all of the required materials without deviation. The bid tabulation is attached.

The bid amount for Fire Hydrants is \$27,170, which is \$3,980 more than the budgeted amount of \$23,190. In a separate Board Item going to the Board for approval on August 19, 2004 is the Water & Sewer System Supplies bid. The bid amount for water supplies is \$15,533.91, which is \$11,426.10 under the budgeted amount of \$26,960. Fire hydrants are budgeted in the same account (Water Distribution Meters/Hydrants/Valves) as the other water supplies so the remaining budget from the water supplies will cover the additional funds needed for the fire hydrants without exceeding the total budget for the account.

Therefore, I am recommending National Waterworks, Inc., the lowest responsible bidder, be awarded a contract in the amount of \$27,170.00. Please submit this recommendation to the Board of Trustees for their approval at the August 19, 2004 meeting.
