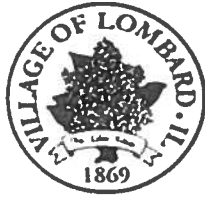

SUBJECT: Liquor License – Greek Island Restaurant

Greek Islander Restaurant, Inc. d/b/a Greek Islands Restaurant currently holds a Class "A/B-III" liquor license. Village staff was recently informed of ownership changes within their corporation, Greek Islander Restaurant, Inc.

Village Code Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.18(D) states that a liquor license shall terminate whenever 50 percent or more of the ownership interest changes from that shown on the original license application. After reviewing their liquor license file, it was noted that their original liquor license application was submitted in 1984 and thereafter, a liquor license was issued. Over the years, the ownership interest has changed to where the 50 percent threshold, inclusive of the most recent changes, has now been exceeded and would necessitate a new liquor license.

Attached is an ordinance decreasing and increasing the Class "A/B-III category by one to reflect the ownership interest changes.

The petitioner is requesting a waiver of first reading to reflect these changes and to accommodate their State liquor license renewal.

ORDINANCE _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS** as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "A/B-III" liquor license, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class "A/B-III" - 14

This decrease in the number of Class "A/B-III" liquor licenses reflects the termination of the Class "A/B-III" liquor license issued to Greek Islander Restaurant, Inc. d/b/a Greek Islands Restaurant, located at 300 E. 22nd Street, as a result of the need for said liquor licensee to obtain a new liquor license because of a change of more than 50% of the ownership interest in Greek Islander Restaurant, Inc.

Section 2: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13 (A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the entry relative to the Class "A/B-III" liquor license, contained therein, to read as follows:

Class "A/B-III" - 15

This increase in the number of Class "A/B-III" liquor licenses reflects the issuance of a new Class "A/B-III" liquor license to Greek Islander Restaurant, Inc. d/b/a Greek Islands Restaurant located at 300 E. 22nd Street, Lombard, IL.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
