**SUBJECT: Text Amendment to Title 11, Chapter 110 Section 110.08(B)(2)
Business Regulations**

Title 11 Business Regulations, Chapter 110 Section 110.08(B)(2) currently states that if there are more than two (2) billiard and/or pool tables at one business location, the business shall be known as a billiard/pool hall.

Interpretation of the Code as currently stated can lead one to believe that if a business is classified as a restaurant in the Zoning Ordinance and contains more than two billiard/pool tables, it should be classified as a billiard/pool hall instead of a restaurant. Because this statement can conflict with the land use interpretation established within the Zoning Ordinance, staff is recommending that this section of Code be changed to reflect that this provision only applies for licensing purposes. Attached is an Ordinance reflecting this proposed change.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 110,
SECTION 110.08(B)(2) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE
IN REGARD TO BILLIARD/POOL HALLS**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 11, Chapter 110, Section 110.08(B)(2) of the Lombard Village Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

(2) Where more than two (2) billiard and/or pool tables are operated or kept for use by the public at one business location, said business shall be known as a billiard/pool hall for licensing purposes only, and the required license fee shall be twenty-five and no/100 dollars (\$25.00) per billiard or pool table, per year.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
