ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 1, CHAPTER 10, SECTION 10.99 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO THE GENERAL PENALTY PROVISION FOR VILLAGE CODE VIOLATIONS

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 1, Chapter 10, Section 10.99 of the Lombard Village Code is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"§ 10.99 GENERAL PENALTY.

Any person, firm or corporation who violates any provisions of this Code, for which another penalty is not specifically provided, shall be subject to a fine of not less than Seventy-Five and No/100 Dollars (\$75.00) nor more than Seven Hundred Fifty and No/100 Dollars (\$750.00). A separate offense shall be deemed committed upon each day during which a violation occurs or continues. In addition to a fine, the Court may impose a period of conditional discharge as defined in 730 ILCS 5/5-1-4 or court supervision as defined in 730 ILCS 5/5-1-21 for a period of up to six (6) months, an order of restitution, an order to perform community service, an order to correct the Code violation by a time certain, an order to complete an education program and/or any other appropriate penalties or conditions authorized in any section of this Code, or any conditions for conditional discharge set forth in 730 ILCS 5/5-6-3 or for court supervision set forth in 730 ILCS 5/5-6-3.1, as the foregoing are amended from time to time."

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
