FY 2012 Road Salt Purchase

The State of Illinois has awarded the contract for rock salt for the FY 2012. The successful bidder this year is North American Salt Company. This year there is a **decrease** in cost of salt by \$12.38; salt contract price will be \$64.10 per ton.

The Village Board approved joint purchase of rock salt with the State of Illinois on March 3, 2011. The Village requisition included an estimated 4,000 tons of salt. The Village is required to purchase 80% of this amount (3,200 tons) or at its option may purchase up to 120% of this amount at the same price (4,800 tons).

Following through on the March 3, 2011 Board approval, authorization is requested to enter into contract with North American Salt Company to purchase 4,000 tons of rock salt at \$64.10 per ton. The purchase order will be in an amount not to exceed \$256,400.00, which is a **decrease** of \$43,600.00 of the original budgeted amount of \$300,000. As a formality, I am requesting a waiver of bids.
