AT 87 YORKTOWN (CAPITAL GRILLE), IN LOMBARD,

ILLINOIS

The Private Engineering Services Division of the Community Development Department recommends that the Board of Trustees accept the public fire hydrants at 87 Yorktown (Capital Grille). Attached is the updated utility map. Please present the attached resolution to the Board of Trustees at their February 16, 2012 meeting.

The stated improvements are acceptable as they were installed substantially to plan and have passed all required tests. The Private Engineering Services Division has approved the project record drawings. The on-site sanitary sewer, fire suppression line (including the line that feeds the public fire hydrant near the building), water service line, and the storm sewer will remain the responsibility of the property owner.

The extensive delay in accepting these improvements was from the length of time necessary to finalize the public watermain easements with Yorktown Mall that were recently accepted by the Board at their February 2, 2012 meeting.
