SUBJECT: Downtown Improvement & Renovation Grant; 15 N. Main Street (MaidPro)

The Community Development Department has received an application for the Downtown Improvement and Renovation Grant Program (also known as the Facade Grant Program) for MaidPro located at 15 N Main Street. The applicant is seeking to install a new channel letter sign, as depicted on the attached plans.

GRANT REQUEST

The tenant is seeking to install a new sign. The applicant has submitted three bids for the proposed work:

Vendor	Price Quote			
Fast Signs	\$3,380			
Aubrey Sign Co.	\$2,550			
Olympic Signs	\$3,995			

The proposed sign is a front-illuminated with channel letters. The proposed sign varies in square footage depending on the vendor and all three would be in compliance with the Sign Ordinance.

Based on the lowest bid, the applicant is eligible to receive up to \$1,275.00 from the Improvement and Renovation Grant program. This request is under \$10,000 and therefore it does not require approval from the Board of Trustees and can be approved by the ECDC.

Staff is not supportive of the request for the following reasons:

- 1. Inconsistent with the recommendations of the Lombard Downtown Revitalization Project Guidebook
- 2. Inconsistent with past approval for other façade grant requests
- 3. Agrees with attached letter from Lombard Town Centre Design Committee

Lombard Downtown Revitalization Project Guidebook focuses on aesthetic standards in Section 4. The design recommendations can be applied to numerous buildings in downtown Lombard. Recommendations include buildings with fabric awnings containing signage and gooseneck lighting, and buildings with fabric awnings, gooseneck lighting, and signage above.

It should be noted that all grant requests paid for by Village of Lombard TIF dollars shall comply with the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act. Therefore, if the grant is approved, the applicant and property owner shall sign an acknowledgement form indicating that they are aware that this project is subject to prevailing wages.

COMMITTEE ACTION REQUESTED

This item is being placed on the November 25, 2013 ECDC agenda for consideration. Staff recommends that the request be denied as it is not consistent with the recommendation set forth within the Lombard Downtown Revitalization Guidebook.

Dear Mr. Jorgji:

The Village of Lombard requested that the Lombard Town Centre Design Committee review your business' signage grant application. Our review process determines if proposed signs comply with the aesthetic guidelines outlined in the *Lombard Downtown Revitalization Project Guidebook* (LDRPG), approved by the Village Board on March 23, 2011.

After conducting our review of your application, we cannot support funding the currently proposed sign with Village grant funds because we feel it does not comply with the façade enhancement guidelines in the LDRPG. We recommend you revise the design to eliminate a raceway-mounted internally-lit channel letter sign and, instead, utilize awning graphics and/or non-internally illuminated sign panels with gooseneck style lighting in order to obtain LTC support for your grant request.

We recognize that there are other internally-illuminated channel letter signs in the downtown. However, none of these signs received Village grant funding. LTC feels strongly that any improvement projects that receive grants from our TIF funds comply with the spirit of the LDRPG.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PURCHASE AGREEMENT

- 2. FIELD CONDITIONS: This agreement is based on standard installation conditions and does not take into consideration any non-standard soil conditions, installations at inaccessible areas, non-standard building conditions, etc. Quotations for installing items onto structures supplied by the Buyer are based on the assumption that the structures furnished by Buyer are structurally sound for accepting the display(s) purchased hereunder without modification. Exterior or interior building rework required to support signs is not included in our Agreement, unless so noted. If the installation requires that plates be placed on the inside of a wall, roof or ceiling, Olympic Signs agrees to perform this work in a workmanlike manner and Buyer agrees to pay for all plastering, redecoration or remodeling the Buyer may desire, unless otherwise specified in this agreement. For remoting of transformers, it is assumed that sufficient access to and behind wall for workmen will be provided by Buyer. Olympic Signs will patch roof or roof covering removed or opened by Olympic Signs during the installation of display, but in making such repairs Olympic Signs assumes no responsibility for rebonding. Olympic Signs shall be responsible for locating and clearing any underground public utilities on the site which affect or obstruct the Work. The Buyer is responsible for informing Olympic Signs of any private underground obstructions (such as sprinkler systems) which may affect or obstruct the Work.
- 3. If display has been erected but Olympic Signs has not completed the electrical connections due to the failure of Buyer to furnish service wiring as provided in this agreement, the balance of the purchase price shall be deemed due and owing.
- 4. PERMITS, LICENSES: Olympic Signs shall obtain all permits, cost to be borne by Buyer, from public authorities for the initial installation of display(s). Buyer shall be responsible for securing and furnishing all private permission necessary from the owner and any mortgagee of the premises upon which display is to be installed. Unless otherwise directed in writing by Buyer, Olympic Signs shall not commence fabrication of the display until all required public permits have been issued. If public permits are denied, then this agreement shall terminate without liability to either party; provided, however, that Buyer shall reimburse Olympic Signs for any permit application costs and any manufacturing costs incurred as a result of prior written direction by Buyer.
- 5. TAXES: Buyer shall pay all personal property, sales, use and other taxes which may be imposed by law on the display or the use thereof. Buyer shall reimburse Olympic Signs for any taxes that may be billed to and paid by Olympic Signs for display.
- 6. Olympic Signs agrees to have all their workmen covered by Worker's Compensation Insurance; and further agrees to carry public Liability Insurance covering injuries to or death of persons and damage to property as a result of accidents for which Olympic Signs is responsible-subject to a single limit of \$1,000.000.00 each occurrence. Buyer shall indemnify and hold Olympic Signs harmless against any and all claims which may be asserted against Olympic Signs by reason of negligence of the Buyer, its agents, employees, or third parties. Insurance Certificates will be furnished to Buyer upon request.
- 7. Buyer bears full responsibility for risk of loss or damage to the display after delivery thereof to the site.
- 8. Title to the display and any other material furnished pursuant to this Agreement shall remain in Olympic Signs until all amounts owing hereunder have been paid in full. Until such amounts have been paid in full, all property furnished hereunder shall be deemed personal property, severable and removable from any realty to which it is attached, and shall not be deemed a fixture or appurtenance to such realty.
- 9. Buyer may not assign this Agreement without the prior written consent of Olympic Signs.
- 10. SELLER'S WARRANTIES: Olympic Signs warrants to Buyer that any display purchased hereunder (excluding lamps as to which Olympic Signs makes no warranty) at the time of delivery or installation, will be free from defects of material and workmanship, and will be in accordance with specifications which are a part of this Agreement. Olympic Signs sole obligation under these warranties is limited to either repair or replacement, at Olympic Signs option, of a defective part or nonconforming display for which written claim is made within 90 days of delivery or installation. All other warranties, whether express or implied, are disclaimed. Note: All gaseous conductor tubes have an inherent tendency to change in color and light intensity proportionate to the period of use. Mercury filled tubing of any age is affected by cold weather. These are universal characteristics and not defects in manufacture. Replacement of operative tubes so affected is not part of this Agreement.
- 11. **DEFAULT:** The occurrence of any of the following events shall constitute a default hereunder: (a) Buyer fails to pay any amounts hereunder when due; (b) Buyer shall fail to perform or observe any other covenant of this agreement; (c) Buyer becomes insolvent or becomes a debtor in Bankruptcy. Upon the occurrence of a default, Olympic Signs may declare all amounts remaining unpaid hereunder to be immediately due and payable. In such event, Olympic Signs shall have the right to enter upon Buyer's premises and take possession of the display or render it inoperable, without any liability whatsoever to Buyer and without relieving Buyer of its obligations hereunder. In the event of a default hereunder, Olympic Signs shall be entitled to recover from Buyer all fees and expenses, including attorney's fees, incurred by Olympic Signs in enforcing its rights hereunder, including any costs incurred in removal of the display.
- 12. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois.
- 13. This Agreement sets forth the entire understanding between the parties regarding the subject matter hereof. The terms of this Agreement may not be terminated, amended, supplemented, waived or modified except in writing signed by Buyer and a duly authorized officer of Olympic Signs.
