
An Ordinance Amending Title 3, Chapter 33 Section 33.06 of the Lombard Village Code in regards to amending fees charged for public education and training classes.

RE : AMENDMENT TO FEE ORDINANCE

Please place before the Board of Trustees for their September 6, 2007, an amendment to the fees for Public Education and Training Classes.

Recent changes by the American Heart Association have significantly increased the cost of supplies and labor to teach the classes. To offset these costs I recommend the following:

- a) Village residents and employees of Village businesses would pay for consumable (not reusable) supplies. The cost of the instructor would be at one half the actual costs based upon seven (7) students in the class.
- b) Non-Village residents would pay the entire cost, based upon seven (7) students in the class.
- c) All students enrolled in an instructor class would pay the entire cost of the class based upon a four (4) student class.
- d) The fire department shall maintain a class fee schedule and a minimum and maximum student level for each class.
- e) Fees shall be rounded to nearest dollar.

Because of the various types of classes and the ever changing costs of supplies the department will maintain a fee schedule based upon the ordinance. Attached is the fee schedule for the classes now available using the new ordinance for fee calculations.

A fee schedule based upon current costs is attached.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3, CHAPTER 33, SECTION 33.06 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO PUBLIC EDUCATION AND TRAINING FEES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That Title 3, Chapter 33, Section 33.06 of the Lombard Village Code is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

(A) The fee charged to Village residents for public education and training classes given by the Village's Fire Department shall be the sum of the actual costs of the following items, to the extent provided relative to each particular course:

1. book(s);
2. consumable material;
3. student supplies; and
4. one-half of the cost of the instructor(s) supplied by the Village based upon seven (7) students.

(B) The fee charged to non-Village residents for public education and training classes given by the Village's Fire Department shall be the same as charged to Village residents, except that the entire cost of the instructor(s) supplied by the Village shall be charged based upon seven (7) students.

(C) The fee charged for Instructor Classes shall be the actual cost of the class with no exclusions based upon four (4) students.

(D) Notwithstanding the foregoing, the fee charged to members of a not-for-profit organization participating in a public education or training class given by the Village's Fire Department shall be capped at the actual cost of student supplies and consumable material.

(E) The department shall maintain a class fee schedule and a minimum student level for each class.

(F) All fees shall be rounded to the nearest dollar.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its

passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

- A class maximum of 10 students, with no exceptions.
