Subject: Transportation and Safety Committee Recommendation

130437; Installation of a Stop Sign at the Intersection of Norbury Ave. and Taylor Rd.

The intersection of Norbury Avenue and Taylor Road is currently controlled by a Yield sign on Norbury Avenue. Due to permanent visual impediments to vehicles traveling on Norbury Avenue (i.e. numerous mature trees and varying topography), coupled with a recent high accident rate history, a Stop sign is warranted for traffic on Norbury Avenue in accordance with the Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD).

During the September 9, 2013 meeting, the Transportation and Safety Committee voted to recommend replacing the existing Yield sign with a Stop sign on Norbury Avenue at Taylor Road by the following modification to the Traffic Code:

DELETE

SCHEDULE V – PREFERENTIAL STREETS

In accordance with Section 10-9-5 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, drivers of vehicles shall yield the right-of-way to the following streets at the intersections designated.

“Norbury Avenue will yield to Taylor Road.”

ADD:

SCHEDULE IV – STOP STREETS

In accordance with Section 10-9-4 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, drivers of vehicles proceeding on the streets designated below shall stop at the following locations.

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard have heretofore passed and approved Ordinance 1186, An Ordinance Regulating Traffic in the Village of Lombard (hereinafter the Lombard Traffic Code); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard find that the Lombard Traffic Code has been amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation and Safety Committee has reviewed the appropriate traffic studies and recommends certain changes to the Lombard Traffic Code; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Lombard concur in the recommendation of the Transportation and Safety Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1: That Schedule V of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled PREFERENTIAL STREETS is amended to delete the following hereto:

"Norbury Avenue will yield to Taylor Road".

Section 2: That Schedule IV of the Lombard Traffic Code (Ordinance 1186) entitled STOP STREETS is amended to add the following hereto:

"Norbury Avenue shall stop at Taylor Road"

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, publication in pamphlet form and the posting of appropriate signs as provided by law.
