LEGAL NOTICE

ORDINANCE NO. 6498

AN ORDINANCE ASCERTAINING THE PREVAILING RATE OF WAGES FOR LABORERS, WORKERS AND MECHANICS EMPLOYED ON PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS IN THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted the "Prevailing Wage Act", as amended (820 ILCS 130/0.01 *et seq.*) (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that the Village of Lombard (the "Village") investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers, in the locality of the Village, employed in performing the construction of public works for the Village;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard, DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: To the extent and as required by the Act, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in the construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of this Village is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the DuPage County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois, as of June 1, 2010, a copy of that determination being attached hereto as **Exhibit "A"** and incorporated herein by reference. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance that are also used in the aforesaid Act shall be the same as in said Act.

SECTION 2: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the Village to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

SECTION 3: The Village Clerk shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of this Village this determination of such prevailing rate of wages. A copy of this determination or of the current revised determination of prevailing rate of wages in effect shall be attached to all contract specifications prepared by the Village.

SECTION 4: The Village Clerk shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed, or file their name and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

SECTION 5: The Village Clerk shall promptly file, but in any event no later than July 15, 2010 a certified copy of this Ordinance with both the Secretary of State, Index Division, and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 6: The Village Clerk shall cause a notice to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the Village that the determination of prevailing wages has been made. Said notice shall conform substantially to the notice attached hereto as **Exhibit "B"** and incorporated herein by reference. Such publication shall constitute notice that this is the determination of the Village and that it is effective as of the date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
