SUBJECT: Water Connection Charges Ordinance

DATE: May 28, 2013

The Department of Public Works requests that the attached ordinance be forwarded to the Village Board of Trustees for inclusion on their June 6, 2013 agenda. This proposed ordinance will revise language in the Village's Fee Schedule (Title 5, Chapter 50, Section 50.100 (D) in the Village Code) regarding water connection fees.

The proposed ordinance will modify the water connection fee structure for non-residential developments and make it more user friendly and keep the costs consistent with the average current fees being charged. The current fee schedule has been in place for a long time and is based on the square footage of the property instead of the actual impact to the Village's water system. The current fee structure allows for a very large connection fee for a small commercial building on a very large parcel of land and a small connection fee for a large commercial building that is on a small parcel of land. The current fee structure has little correlation to the actual impact to the system. It also does not allow the Village to charge for upsizing of the water service lines for expansions as size of the building gets larger, which impacts the Village's system more.

The revised fee structure is not intended to increase the fees, but to keep the fees in line with the fees currently being collected from developers for connecting to the Village's water supply and brings the way the Village assesses these fees into a similar set up as many of the other communities in DuPage County. The proposed domestic connection fee is based on the calculation performed from the water study conducted in 2003 and updated for current water usage numbers in 2012. The fire suppression line connection fee format was structured similarly to another municipality where they doubled the cost as the size of the fire suppression size increased. The fire suppression line connection fee was then adjusted to keep the average fees in line with current fees being taken in under the existing fee structure. This change will not affect residential properties.

Below is a summary of how the revised water connection fee would be affected:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 5, CHAPTER 50, SECTION 50.100(D) OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO THE WATER CONNECTION CHARGES FOR COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LAND USES

BE IT ORDAINED by the president and board of trustees of the Village of Lombard, Du Page County, Illinois, as follows:

<u>SECTION 1:</u> That Title 5, Chapter 50, Section 50.100 (D) of the Lombard Village Code is amended to read in its entirety as follows:

- "(D) Connection charges for commercial and industrial land uses as determined by classification under the zoning ordinance shall be calculated as follows:
 - (1) The charge for each water service connection, whether a domestic line connection or a fire suppression line connection, shall be based upon the diameter of the water service pipe as follows:

(a) Size of Domestic Line		<u>Charge</u>
i.	one (1") inch in diameter	\$630.00
ii.	one and a half (1.5") inches in diameter	\$1,130.00
iii.	two (2") inches in diameter	\$2,000.00
iv.	three (3") inches in diameter	\$3,560.00
v.	four (4") inches in diameter	\$6,330.00
vi.	six (6") inches in diameter	\$11,260.00
(b) Size of Fire Suppression Line		Charge
i.	four (4") inches in diameter	\$4,250.00
ii.	six (6") inches in diameter	\$8,500.00
iii.	eight (8") inches in diameter	\$17,000.00

(2) The charge paid for the existing size shall be credited against the charge for any future upsizing required due to a building addition or a change of use.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
