FY12 Vehicle Joint Purchase

Included in the FY 2012 budget is the replacement for a Public Works Sewer Division 4x4 pickup truck with plow (unit # SM443). This vehicle is available for purchase through the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative (SPC). The current contract winner for the SPC is Currie Motors of Frankfort (IL). The cost of the truck is \$32,392. Currie Motors has offered a \$11,000 trade-in allowance for our old truck; this makes the total amount needed for this purchase \$21,392. The budgeted amount we have in reserve for this purchase is \$22,000.

I recommend the B.O.T. waive bid and award a contract to Currie Motors of Frankfort (IL) in the amount of \$21,392 for one new 4x4 pickup truck with plow. I also recommend declaring Village unit # SM443 as surplus per the attached ordinance and authorizing its trade-in. Waiver of first reading is requested on this ordinance. Please submit this item to the Village Board for their consideration at the March 23, 2011 meeting.
