Currently employees must be twenty-one (21) years of age to sell alcohol with the exception of an establishment holding a Class A/B III liquor license which allows liquor license holders to employ waiters/waitresses between the age of eighteen (18) years and the age of twenty-one (21) years. Rock Bottom Brewery has requested that their class of license, Class "Z", also be included with this exception.

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112, OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.33 (B) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the last sentence as follows:

"Notwithstanding the foregoing, it shall not be unlawful for anyone between the age of eighteen (18) years and the age of twenty-one (21) years from serving alcoholic liquor in the capacity of a waiter or waitress employed by an establishment holding a Class "A/B-III" or "Z" liquor license."
