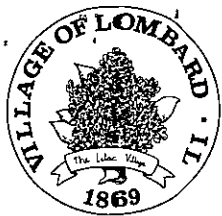

SUBJECT: Liquor Code Amendment

Currently employees must be twenty-one (21) years of age to sell alcohol with the exception of an establishment holding a Class A/B III liquor license which allows liquor license holders to employ waiters/waitresses between the age of eighteen (18) years and the age of twenty-one (21) years. Rock Bottom Brewery has requested that their class of license, Class "Z", also be included with this exception.

ORDINANCE _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS** as follows:

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.33 (B) of the Lombard Village Code is amended by revising the last sentence as follows:

“Notwithstanding the foregoing, it shall not be unlawful for anyone between the age of eighteen (18) years and the age of twenty-one (21) years from serving alcoholic liquor in the capacity of a waiter or waitress employed by an establishment holding a Class “A/B-III” or “Z” liquor license.”

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
