“The sale of alcoholic beverages shall be in individual containers and may not be purchased in bulk amounts, other than with bulk food orders. The capacity for serving patrons should not be less than 100patrons, at any combination of tables, booths and bars which reflect the character of the establishment as a self service restaurant rather than as an establishment set up to serve alcoholic beverages as its principal activity.”
