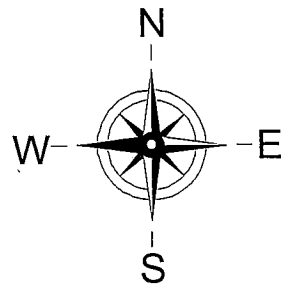
Subject: Parking on Kelly Ct.

Attached is a drawing showing the proposed "No Parking" zone.

I would recommend installing "No Parking" signs as indicated on the drawing to improve the traffic flow on Kelly Ct.

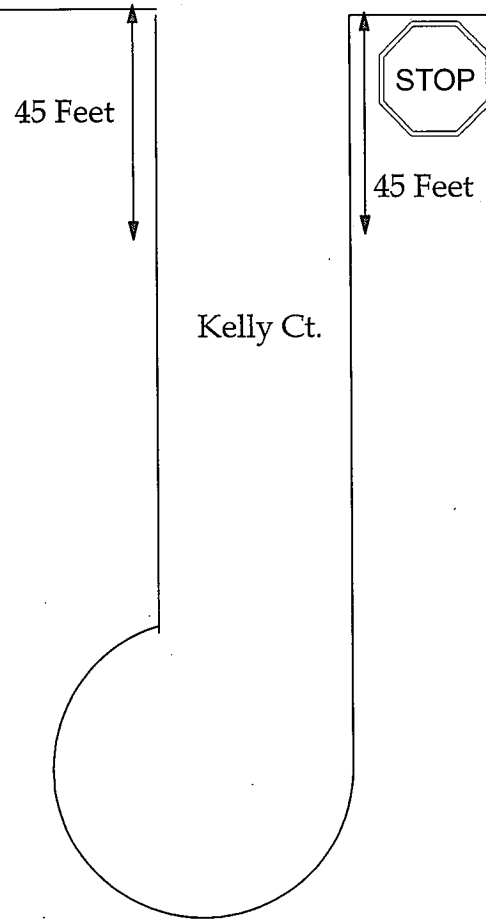
