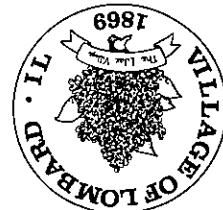

Waiver of Bids and Award of a Contract for Sidewalk Snow and Ice Removal
FY2009

Staff had budgeted \$53,980 for the removal of ice and snow from various sidewalks throughout the Village and awarded a contract to Pavescap, Inc. on November 20, 2008. Due to the amount of snow events already experienced this winter season Public Works has processed (2) two Change Orders totaling \$26,500, the last which was approved by the Board of Trustees on February 5, 2009. Currently there are outstanding bills totaling \$1,875 and we still have at least 1 month of winter to go. In my best estimation for cost of Snow and Ice Removal for the remainder of the winter season would be an additional \$20,000.00.

This price is an hourly rate per person including equipment. They use a six person crew. The Village will supply all de-icing materials to the contractor. Their responsibility is to remove the snow and ice along with spreading the de-icing materials.

I am requesting the Board of Trustees waive bids and award an additional contract to Pavescap, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$20,000 bringing the total Sidewalk Snow and Ice Removal costs to \$100,480 for the removal of ice and snow from various Village maintained sidewalks for FY2009 winter season.

Please present this item to the Village Board for consideration at the March 5, 2009, meeting.
