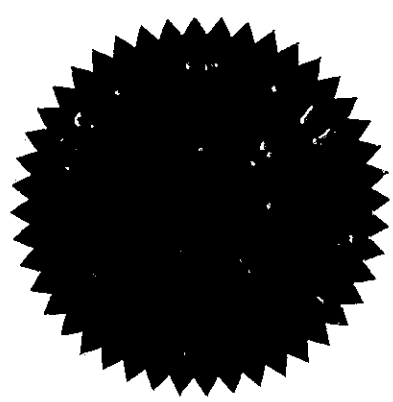

CHAPTER 116 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE
IN REGARD TO LICENSES AND PERMITS

ORDINANCE 4540

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 1, CHAPTER 13, AND TITLE 11,
CHAPTER 116 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO LICENSES AND PERMITS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Lombard,

DuPage County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 1, Chapter 13 of the Lombard Village Code is amended by adding

new Sections 13.06 and 13.07 thereto which shall read in their entirety as follows:

"§13.06 LICENSE AND PERMIT FEES -
NON-REFUNDABLE.

In light of the fact that the Village incurs substantial administrative expenses in the processing of applications for licenses and permits authorized by this Code, the fee submitted along with an application for any such license or permit shall be non-refundable, unless the specific Code provision requiring said fee provides otherwise.

§13.07 LICENSES AND PERMITS -
NON-TRANSFERRABLE.

Licenses and permits authorized by this Code shall be non-transferrable once issued."

SECTION 2: That Title 11, Chapter 116, Section 116.01 of the Lombard Village Code is

amended by adding a new subsection (E) thereto which shall read in its entirety as follows:

"(E) Pursuant to Section 13.06 of this Code, the fee submitted along with an application for any license or permit authorized by this Code shall be non-refundable, unless the specific Code provision requiring said fee provides otherwise."

SECTION 3: That Title 11, Chapter 116, Section 116.02 of the Lombard Village Code is

amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"§116.02 - NON-TRANSFERABILITY.

Pursuant to Section 13.07 of this Code, the licenses and permits authorized by this Code shall be non-transferable once issued."

SECTION 4: That Title 11, Chapter 116, Section 116.03 of the Lombard Village Code is

hereby repealed.

SECTION 5: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its

passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.




