The bid documents were prepared to allow the Village to award a contract to the budgeted amount of \$105,000.00. This is a year long contract. ## CONTRACT

### CONTRACT DOCUMENT NUMBER SAN-10-01

This agreement is made this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2009, between and shall be binding upon the Village of Lombard, an Illinois municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to as the "Village") and United Septic, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor") and their respective successors.

Witnessed, that in consideration of the mutual promises of the parties delineated in the Contract Documents, the Contractor agrees to perform the services and the Village agrees to pay for the following services as set forth in the Contract Documents:

The FY 2010 Sewer Televising and Cleaning will entail the televising and cleaning of various sanitary, storm and combined sewers all located within the Village of Lombard. The quantities in the bid proposal are estimates since the locations of the future locations are unknown. Actual quantities may increase or decrease from the bid proposals. Work orders will be issued to identify locations and quantities. The contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder based on the quantities and unit prices in the bid proposal. The awarded contract will be the Village's budgeted amount. Payment for work performed will be based on measured quantities multiplied by the contract unit prices.

1. This contract shall embrace and include all of the applicable Contract Documents listed below as if attached hereto or repeated herein:
  - a. Contract Document Number SAN-10-01 for FY 2010 Sewer Televising and Cleaning, consisting of the following:
    - i) Cover Sheet
    - ii) Table of Contents
    - iii) Notice to Bidders on Contract Document Number SAN-10-01 - Legal Notice
    - iv) General Provisions
    - v) Special Provisions
    - vi) Plans and Specifications
  - b. The Contractor's Bid Proposal Dated: 8/11/09

c. Required Performance and Payment Bonds and Certificate(s) of Insurance

d. Executed Bidder's Certification Form.

2. The Village agrees to pay, and the Contractor agrees to accept as full payment the amount as shown on the Contractor's Bid Proposal, which is made a part hereof, subject to such additions and deletions as agreed to by the parties hereto.
3. The Contractor shall commence work under this Contract upon written Notice to Proceed from the Village and shall complete work under this contract by May 31, 2010. Time is of the essence in regard to this Contract, and the Contractor agrees to achieve completion within the time permitted by all proper and appropriate means including working overtime without additional compensation.
4. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 5 of the Mechanics' Lien Act of Illinois, prior to making any payment to the Contractor under this Contract, the Village demands that the Contractor furnish a written statement of the names of all parties furnishing labor and/or materials under this Contract and the amounts due or to become due each. This statement must be made under oath or be verified by affidavit. The Village shall not issue final payment nor shall any retained percentage become due until releases and waivers of lien have been supplied as the Village designates.
5. This Contract represents the entire agreement between the parties and may not be modified without the written approval of both parties.
