ORDINANCE _____

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 11, CHAPTER 112,
SECTION 112.13 OF THE LOMBARD VILLAGE CODE IN
REGARD TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE VILLAGE OF LOMBARD, DU PAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS as follows:**

Section 1: That Title 11, Chapter 112, Section 112.13(A) of the Lombard Village Code is amended BY REVISING THE ENTRY RELATIVE TO THE Class A/B-I liquor licenses contained therein, to read as follows:

“Class A/B-I – 8”

Section 2: That the change in the number of Class A/B-I liquor licenses set forth in Section 1 above, is a result of Lioness Restaurant Group Inc. d/b/a French Quarter, New Orleans Kitchen no longer conducting business at 44 Yorktown Convenience Center.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
